### **Season & Species**

Sailfish are abundant year round, since 1994, the fleet has averaged raising more than 20 billfish per day per boat – YEAR ROUND! Our rainy season of mid-July through September coincide with the slower travel period of our typical client, with October through June being prime booking months. The larger sailfish up to 150 pounds are usually taken during the Fall, but for pure volume of 80 – 100 pound fish, December through June tends to be the rule.

During this time you'll be tantalized with 20 – 40 bites per day and, on some of those exceptional days, more than 100! Our statistics show 40 plus sailfish release days have been experienced in every month of the year. Fly

fisherman take note: feather tossing anglers aboard the RELEASE let go 57 sailfish in one day in 2006 and they did it while conforming to all IGFA rules and regulations. Days with finicky or non-aggressive feeders are few and far between!

Marlin add to the excitement and they generally show up in concentrations for a week or more several times a year. At any time, a run to the far offshore drop can normally put you on yellowfin tuna as well as the average 400 pound blue marlin. As an average, while targeting sailfish every Casa Vieja boat will encounter a marlin every third day during the year. This number can be seriously upped by requesting a strictly marlin venture!

Throughout the year there are lots of football size tuna and dolphin in the 20 – 40 pound range to be caught, should that be your choice. Along the coastline, and within minutes of the docks, roosterfish are plentiful and of impressive size. This type of fishing is also done the comfortable way by all vessels in our fleet. Scheduling a day of inshore fishing is an excellent way to round off your trip.

## **Terms & Conditions**

**The Fine Print:** (please read carefully)

**Deposits:** Deposits are due 7 days after booking in our Gainesville reservations office. Deposits are 50% of the package rate times the number of guests. RESERVATIONS ARE NOT CONFIRMED until your deposit is received. If no deposit is received and/or posted 14 days after you have been invoiced, your reservation is subject to cancellation and the space can be sold to customers requesting space. We will then wait list you for that week as a courtesy, should space become available. \*Subject to change for last minute bookings.

**Balances:** The final payment (the balance on your invoice) is due in our Gainesville office 60 days before the departure date of your trip. We accept checks and all major credit cards. \* Last minute bookings must be paid in full before arrival.

**Cancellation Policy:** If you must cancel your trip for any reason, we will try to re-sell your dates. If we are able to do so, a refund less \$150 per person fee, will be given. However, if we are unable to re-sell your dates, you will lose up to half of your deposit. If you cancel your trip, for whatever reason, 75 days, or less, prior to your arrival date at Casa Vieja Lodge, all payments made on your trip will be non-refundable. If you cancel and re-schedule your trip within 360 days you will only be responsible for the extra fees involved and \$50 per person.

**Cancellations due to Weather:** If bad weather arises and your Captain determines that for safety sake the trip should not be taken – you will receive a refund for that day’s fishing. If, however, you choose to not go out – there will be no refund.

**Boats and Captains:** The boat captains listed on our web pages are the primary captains within our fleet and are the most professional in Guatemala, typically fishing 150 days a year. Occasionally, due to illness or the need for an occasional day of rest, we will substitute a captain for a given vessel. Most of our first mates are also accomplished captains with many years of experience and can stand in, in an emergency. Also, like any business, from time to time we do have changes due to promotions. These situations may also require a change of captains on certain vessels. Again, the substitution or change of captain does not happen very often, but we do reserve the right make crew substitutions and changes when necessary.

**Hotel Refunds:** Any cancellation within 72 hours of arrival for pre-paid reservations and/or tours are non-refundable

**Travel Insurance:** Recommended, in the event of a family emergency, an act of God, or any other unforeseen situation that would require you to cancel your trip.
